OUR MISSION

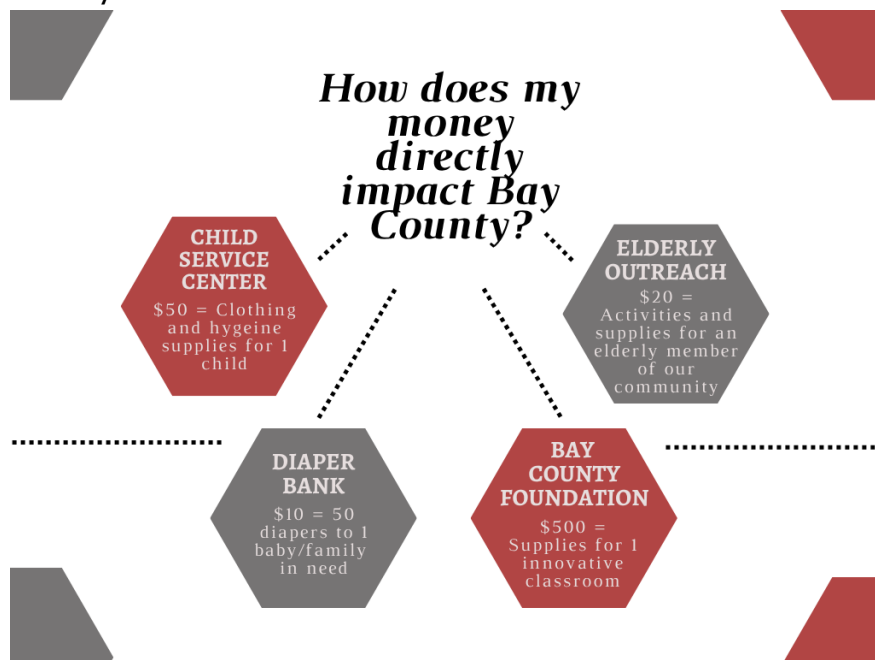
The Junior League of Panama City, Inc is an organization of women whose mission is to advance women's leadership for community impact through volunteer action, collaboration and training.

OUR VISION

The Junior League of Panama City works to identify the unmet needs in our community and develops unique programs to fulfill those needs along with the resources and trained volunteers to sustain those programs. Our organization provides Bay County with a valuable commodity – trained volunteers for community and civic leadership.

OUR COMMUNITY IMPACT

With more than **350 members**, our organization implements research and development of community programs in Bay County through service projects, collaborations, education and advocacy. Each year our members contribute more than 5,000 volunteer hours to support outreach programs and carry out our mission. Last year, the Child Service Center touched the lives of **441** students in Bay County, ensuring they could attend school with confidence by providing school-approved clothing. CSC continues to fill critical gaps for families in need, supporting dignity, equity, and academic readiness. Kids in the Kitchen provided **456** healthy afterschool snacks to students at both ASAP locations—Glenwood and Panavilla—promoting nutrition and wellness.. Through a partnership with Bay Education Foundation, JLPC helped to award **\$14,500** to area teachers for innovative classroom use. The Diaper Bank distributed **53,040 diapers to 1,182 children** in Bay County, helping to ease the financial burden on families. By filling this essential need, the program supported parents in maintaining employment, ensured children could remain in daycare, and contributed to improved health and hygiene outcomes for the youngest members of our community. These are just a few of the projects where JLPC volunteers impact our community. By supporting our mission, you are making a lasting investment for the present and future needs of Bay County.
